

QUILT 2 END ALZ, INC.

6" LOG CABIN BLOCK


Raw block measures 6.5" x 6.5" Press seams towards darker fabric unless otherwise noted. WOF = Width of Fabric; Pattern assumes WOF is 42''. Use a scant ¼'' seam throughout.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

If you would like to precut your logs, here are the measurements for each strip. (If not, we love to do strip-piecing with these blocks and trim each strip as we go.)

> Log 1: 1.25" x 3.5" Log 2: 1.25" x 4.25" Log 3: 1.25" x 4.25" Log 4: 1.25" x 5"

Log 5: 1.25" x 5" Log 6: 1.25" x 5.75" Log 7: 1.25" x 5.75" Log 8: 1.25" x 6.5"



MAKING THE BLOCKS


I. Prepare strips according to cutting instructions.

2. Using one center square and your first purple strip (L1) with right sides facing one another, line up and sew along the right-side edge.


If not precut, trim the "tail" of the purple strip to line up with the edge of the center square.

3. Press open with seam allowance going away from center square.

4.Add on to the center block using your second purple strip (L2).Take the center block (facing down) and align it right sides together with L2 (underneath and facing up). L1 should be across the top. Line up and sew along the right-side edge. *Trim the tail (if applicable).*



5. Press open with seam allowance going away from center square.



6.Add on to the center block again, this time using your third purple strip (L3). Just like before, the previous log (L2) runs across the top of the center block and faces down. The new log (L3) runs along the right edge facing up so that the right sides are together. Stitch along the right-side edge.

7. Continue this process with each log until all L2 logs are sewn, always facing the log cabin block down with the previous strip across the top from left to right and placing the new log strip along the right-side edge facing up.
